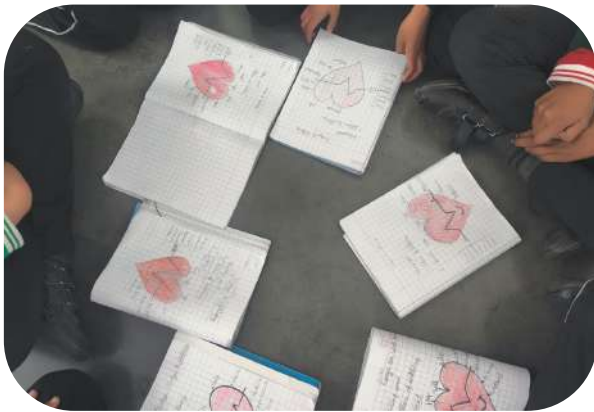

Subject Enrichment English

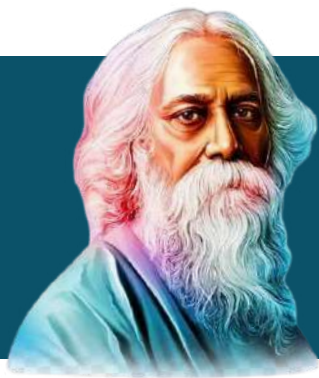
Act It Out

That's true happiness!

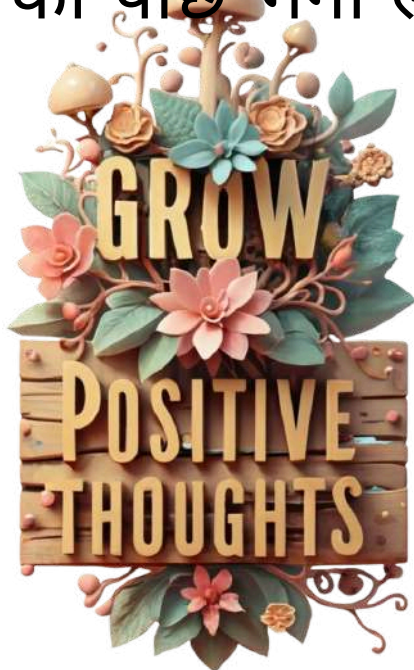
